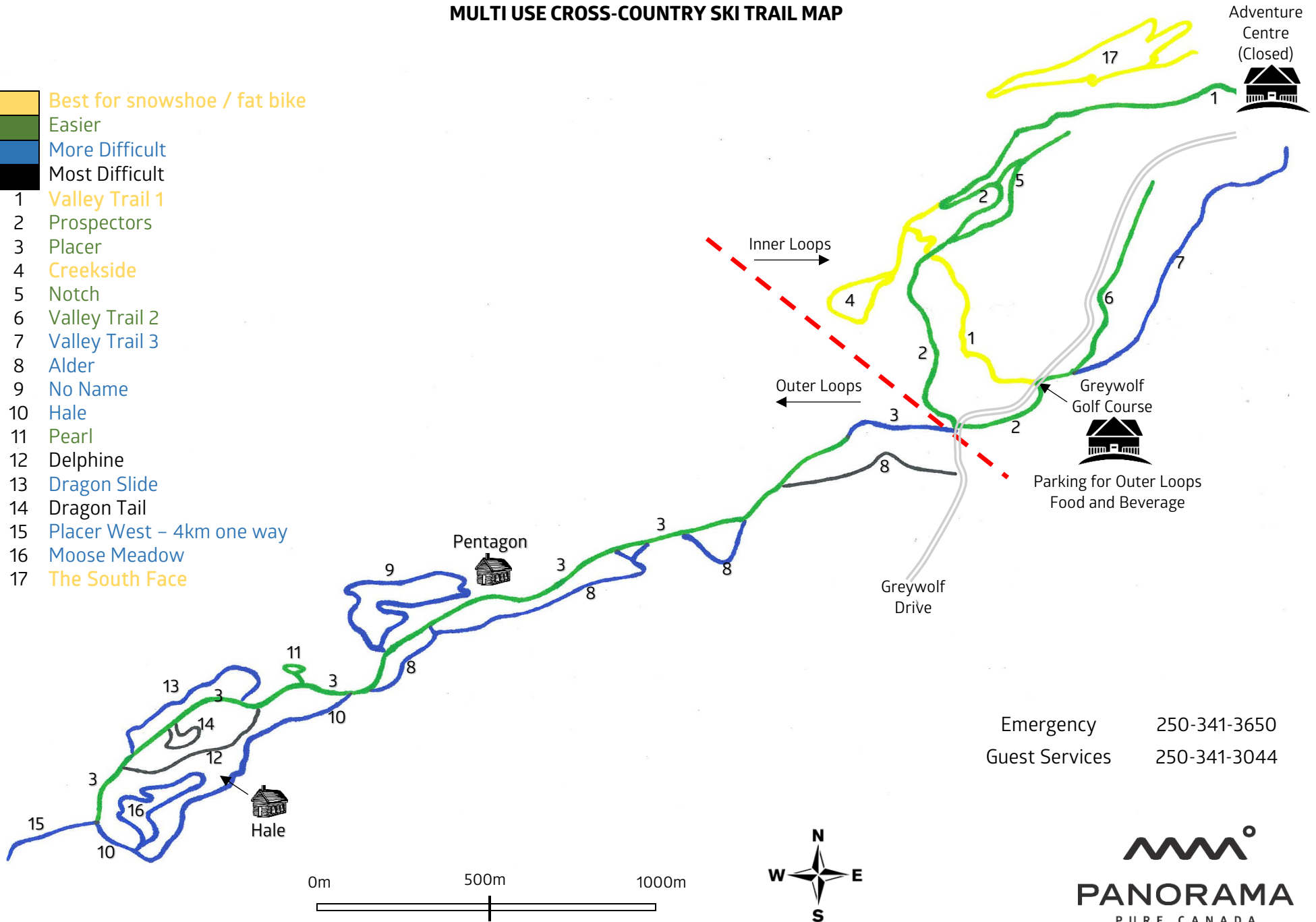


MULTI USE CROSS-COUNTRY SKI TRAIL MAP

Trail Fees

Trail passes are required for all activities: Nordic skiing, snow shoeing, fat biking. Tickets are available at the Guest Services in the upper village. The trails are groomed on a regular basis. Please visit PanoramaResort.com/Nordic-trail-conditions for the latest grooming report.

Inner Loops

The inner loops are located closest to the Adventure Centre in the lower village. They are groomed with a snowmobile and Yellowstone track setter. These trails offer a classic track and at times can be wide enough for skate skiing. These trails are relatively flat and great for learning.

Outer Loops

The outer loops are accessed beginning with Placer. They are groomed with a full-sized snow cat. The outer loops offer the best classic and skate skiing experience at Panorama. For direct access to the outer loops, guests may choose to drive to the Greywolf Golf Course parking lot after paying for trail fees. Cliffhanger Restaurant is open for lunch and dinner. However, it is not a day lodge. Please secure your belongings in your vehicle.

Etiquette

Panorama's trails are multi use. Your chosen activity affects other trail users. Do not walk or bike on the classic Nordic track. Freshly groomed trails are soft. If you are sinking and leaving large ruts, consider another trail. Dogs are welcome, but owners must clean up after their pets.
